Only 18% digital loan borrowers understand data privacy rules: Study

Indians are increasingly using digital services for loans and other financial transactions but they are poorly informed about data privacy, said Home Credit India's 'How India Borrows Survey 2023' survey released on Wednesday.

Only 18 per cent of the borrowers surveyed understood data privacy rules and 88 per cent had a superficial understanding. "As India accelerates into the digital lending era, the study underlines a concern among borrowers regarding the usage of their personal data by loan companies," it said. MANWIT SAHA
