



# NDSA report an indictment of BRS govt, says Uttam

The National Dam Safety Authority's (NDSA) report on the Kaleshwaram Project is a direct indictment of the BRS government, exposing serious flaws in its design, construction, and maintenance, Irrigation and Civil Supplies Minister Capt. N. Uttam Kumar

Reddy said.

Addressing the media during the Bharat Summit 2025 at the HICC on Friday, Uttam launched a blistering attack on the BRS leadership, stating, "BRS leaders should have some shame. The NDSA report clearly stated that the design was faulty, the construction was faulty, and the operation and maintenance were faulty. Soil testing was not done properly, and no proper geophysical investigations were conducted."

Highlighting the report's findings, he pointed out that the sand piping phenomenon, cavity formation underneath the raft, construction defects, design deficiencies, structural distress, and other downstream damage **Continued on Page**
