

Bharat Summit to pass resolution on terrorism today

The two-day Bharat Summit is going to pass a resolution on terrorism on the second day, that is, Saturday.

The Congress Working Committee's (CWC) permanent invitee, Gurudeep Singh Sappal, said that on the first day of the Bharat Summit, which is going on at the HICC Novotel Hotel on Friday, the nation is protesting against the terror attack in Pahalgalam.
